

## 2022 POATRI Board of Directors Election Results

The role of the Independent Vote Counter (IVC) is restricted to (a) ensuring independence of the voting process and (b) reporting the results. S/he must depend on the board to interpret POATRI's policies, procedures and bylaws as they apply to this work.

Our IVC this year was Ken Durham.

### Two of the Nine Candidates were Elected

POATRI bylaws require successful candidates to receive votes from at least 50% (plus one vote) of the valid ballots submitted. Two of the nine candidates passed this threshold and were elected.

- Brad Anthenat (74.4%)
- Barbara Levedahl (67.4)

The rest field received 46.5% or less and were unsuccessful.

### Automatic Recount NOT Triggered

According to the July 2020 revision of the POA's P&Ps, the difference between the person elected with the least number of votes (Barbara Levedahl @ 335 votes) and the person not elected with the most (Pam Gordon @ 231) must be 2% or less than the person elected with the least to trigger an automatic recount. This year the difference was 104 votes, or 31%; therefore, no recount was automatically triggered.

### Member Meeting is Authorized

According to the language on the ballot, a member meeting is authorized if 10% of the property owners in good standing, or at least 278 of 2,776, agree to have their ballot count towards a quorum. The meeting was authorized with 381 voting YES.
